

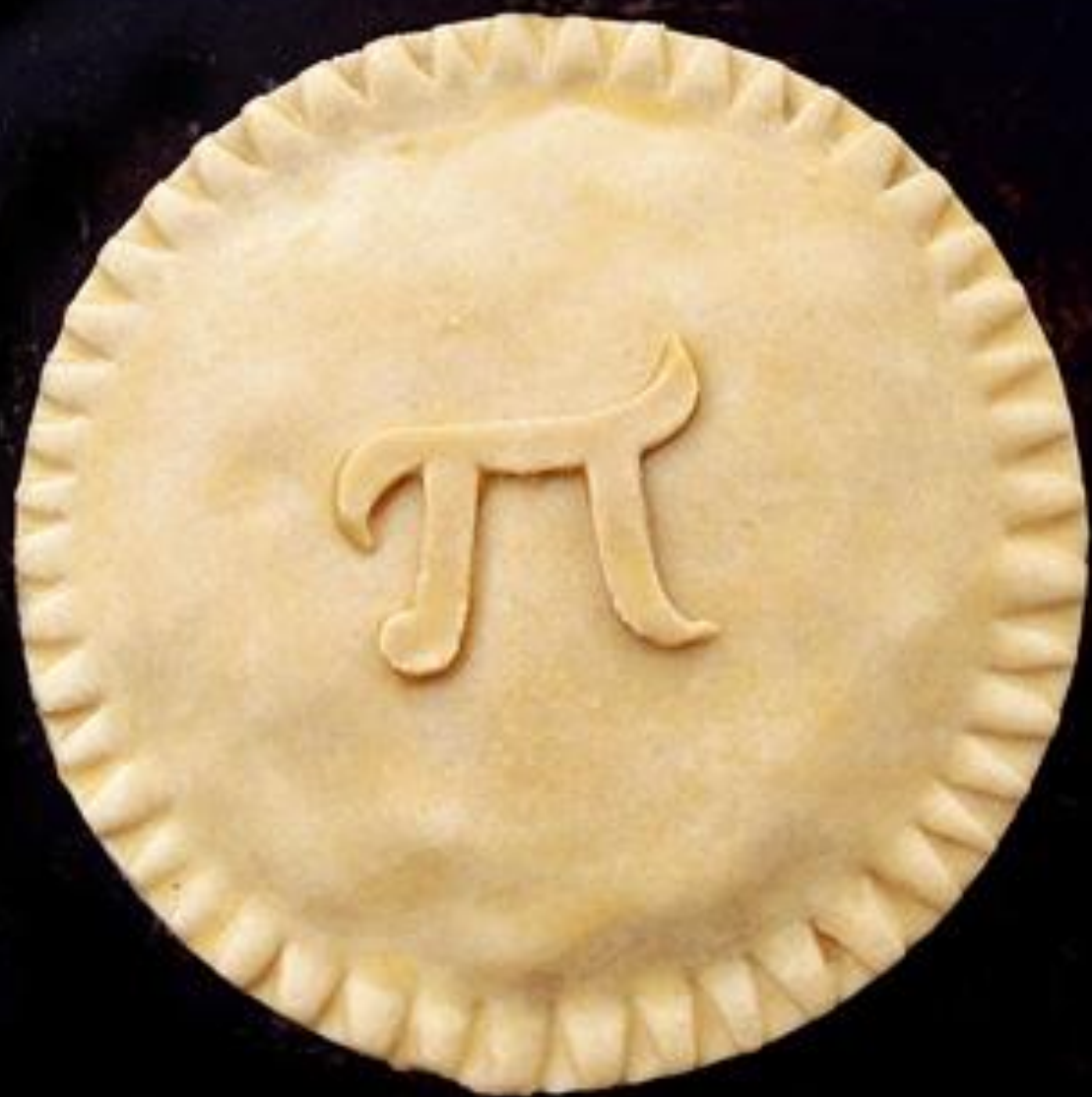

# A Legacy That Lasts

## 1. Proclaim the Gospel

- 2 Timothy 4:17

*“...the Lord stood at my side and gave me strength, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it.”*



# A Legacy That Lasts

## 1. Proclaim the Gospel

- *Philippians 1:20-21*

*“I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or death. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.”*



# A Legacy That Lasts

- **G** - God created us to be with Him. (Gen. 1-2)
- **O** - Our sins separate us from Him. (Gen. 3)
- **S** - Sins cannot be removed by good deeds. (Gen. 4-Mal. 4)
- **P** - Paying the price for sin, Jesus died and rose again. (Matt.-Luke)
- **E** - Everyone who trusts in Him alone has eternal life. (John)
- **L** - Life with Jesus starts now and lasts forever. (Acts-Rev.)



# A Legacy That Lasts

## 2. Invest in Others

- Invite the person to watch what you do.  
(bring them along with you)
- Invite the person to do what you do with you.  
(do the task together)



# A Legacy That Lasts

## 2. Invest in Others

- Invite the person to do what you do, with you watching and coaching. (they do the task you watch)
- Invite the person to do what you do without you while you encourage and support as needed. (They repeat what you did with someone else)



# A Legacy That Lasts

## 3. Embrace your Suffering

- 2 Timothy 4:17a

*“But the Lord stood at my side and gave me strength...”*

-2 Corinthians 12:9

*“The Lord said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.”*
